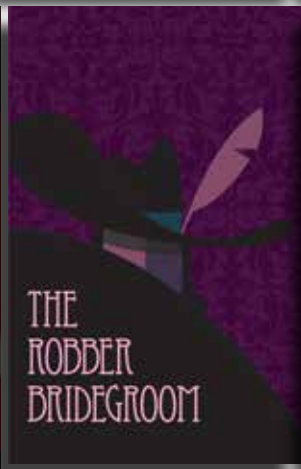

What We Do

The mission of the Littleton Town Hall Arts Center is to enrich the cultural, social, and educational life of the community through professionally produced live theatre, concerts, other cultural events and year-round educational programs for children and adults. 2016-17 marked our **35th Anniversary**.

Attendance for all 133 performances this season totaled over 28,500 with over 3,250 attending Town Hall Arts Center for the first time this season. Preview performances of each main stage musical were attended by over 1,050 underprivileged individuals served by ArtReach, Above and Beyond, the Colorado Center for the Blind, Libby Bortz Assisted Living and volunteers of the Denver Zoo.

Awards

Town Hall Arts Center received one nomination for the 2017 Henry Awards. Kelly Kates was nominated for **Outstanding Choreography in a Musical** for *The Robber Bridegroom*.

In addition to the Henry Award nominations, Town Hall Arts Center also received three Marlowe Awards and was nominated in eleven Broadway World categories. *Once Upon a Mattress* received nomination for **Best Comedic Musical** and Taylor Nicole Young received a nomination for **Best Actress in a Musical** in *Once Upon A Mattress*. *Avenue Q* received a nomination for **Best Comedic Musical**. In addition, its directors and cast received six nominations. Charlie Schimdt was nominated as **Best Actor in a Musical**. Carolyn Lohr was nominated for **Best Actress in a Musical**, and Patrick Brownson received a nomination as **Best Supporting Actor in a Musical**. Nick Sugar received a nomination for **Best Director of a Musical** as well as **Best Choreography of a Musical**. Donna Debreceni was nominated as **Best Music Director**, and the *Avenue Q* ensemble received a nomination as **Best Small Ensemble of a Musical**. *Bonnie & Clyde* received two nominations. It was nominated as **Best Dramatic Musical**, and Nick Sugar was nominated as **Best Director of a Musical**. Nick Sugar also received a nomination for **Best Choreography of a Musical** for *Hairspray*.

What We Do

Town Hall Children's Programming

In the summer of 2016, 1,558 persons attended eight summer camp performances of the teens' *Suessical Jr.*, and another 319 attended the two performances of *Midsummer Night's Dream*, the second production camp for our older students. An additional 353 persons attended our youngsters' two performances of *Jump 'N' Jive Juliet*. Another 1,490 adults and children attended our eight holiday performances of *A Participation Christmas Carol*. The total audience for our youth performances in 2016-17 was 3,720. We also held multiple sessions of our **Actor's Playground** – children's theater workshop classes for ages 5 - 18 (6 summer sessions, 5 fall sessions, 5 winter/spring sessions) that served 298 students. Town Hall Arts Center's inaugural Mark Stahlman Memorial Classes for students with disabilities and special needs served 24 students during 2016-2017.

Our outreach program, **Arts on the Move**, took 67 performances and workshops to schools, day care centers, other venues or here at Town Hall Arts Center, reaching over 5,100 participants who could not have experienced our children's theatre activities otherwise.

Stanton Art Gallery

Depot Artists at Town Hall featured artists Cheryl Adams, Gail Firmin, Scott Lines, Sheila Marie, Paul Nutting and Sue Williams Hang. *Les Trois Tracys* featured artists Tracy Haines, Tracy Wall and Tracy Williams. The final show of the season was *Salon d' Littleton* featuring artists Rita Campbell, Patti Harrison, Rachel Hueske and Karen Kennedy.

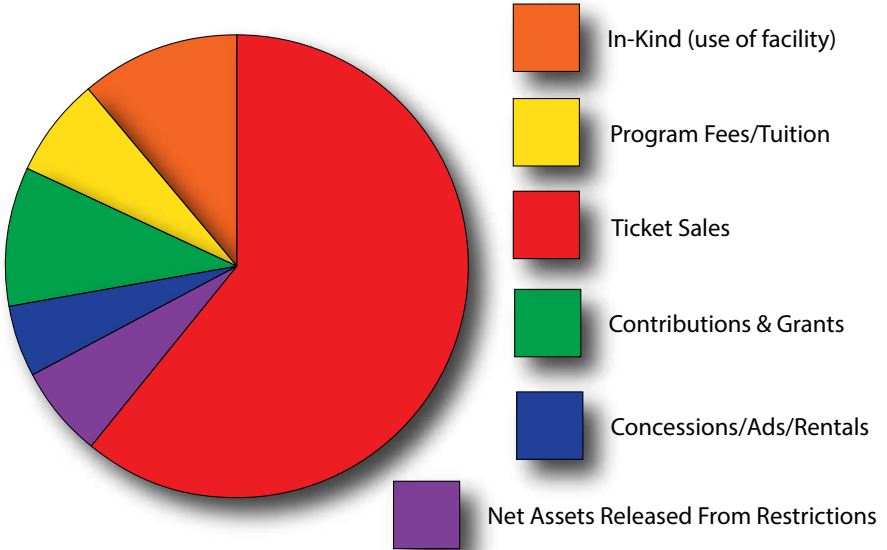

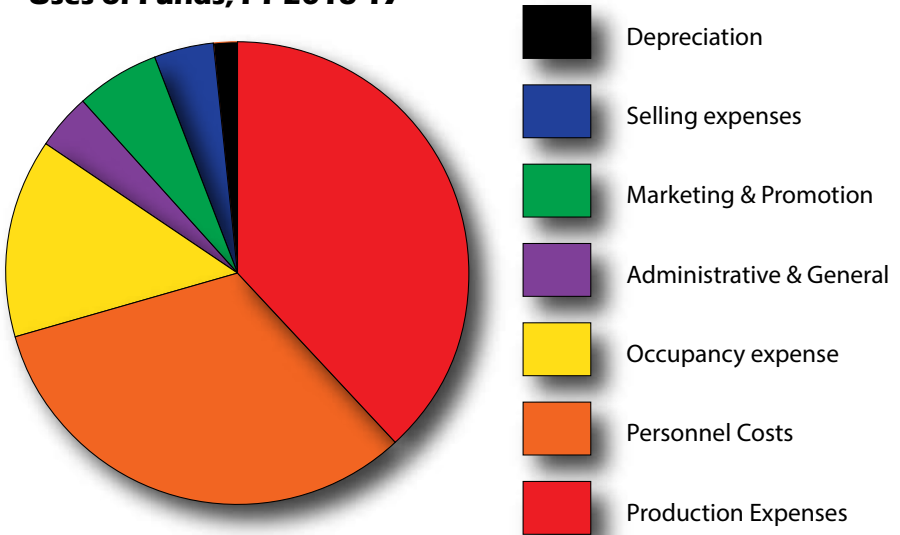
