


#### **Performances**

All roles are paid a \$500 rehearsal stipend and a per-show rate between \$65 and \$75 for performances. Understudies will receive an additional rehearsal stipend. Swings are paid a \$500 rehearsal stipend and \$100 per week on-call stipend for the run, plus a per-show rate for any performances they cover.
